2014 CSR Activities

1. Be Strong 1-4/02/2014

Volunteers informed the shopping centre's visitors about the work of non-profit organisation "BE STRONG" for the support of people with cancer.

2. SKAI – All together for the child, 29.03.2014

SKAI, in partnership with the National Bank of Greece, keeps supporting the children in need. The SKAI action titled "All together for the child" took place in anticipation of Easter to send people the message: "BE A GODPARENT THIS EASTER". The campaign's purpose was to gather clothing, toys, Easter candles and shoes; that is, what the children's godparents would have bought them. The items collected were given to charity "Together for the child" to cover its needs. A small celebration with surprises and happenings for the children was held. The children enjoyed a show by a children's entertainer and a clown in front of the ibank branch.

3. SKAI – All together for the child, 06.09.2014

The National Bank of Greece and SKAI keep supporting the children in need. To this end, for the second year in a row, they gathered school stationery for children who need it and "filled their backpacks with smiles".
