ALMA - Easter Bazaar

On December 19th, 2015 a music event was held by Saint Alexander's Choir in open space with religious and Christmas music selections in order to entertain marina's visitors.



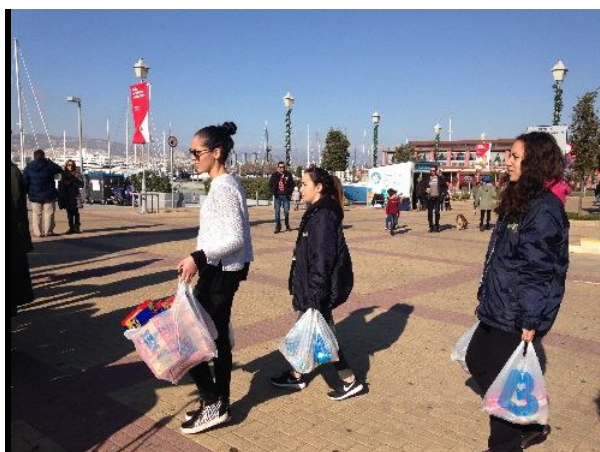
Musical Movement

LAMDA Flisvos Marina S.A. places particular emphasis not only on the monitoring and implementation of cutting edge technologies and practices but also on the informing, training and participation of employees in environmental management. The following exercises were held in 2015:

Evacuation Tutoring

Flisvos Marina completed the evacuation training on Tuesday 3rd and Thursday 5th, February 2015. The purpose of the training was to inform the personnel, the security staff, cleaners, etc., as well as the shop employees, for the procedure of the emergency evacuation of the marina. The aim of education is to protect human life and the property.

Evacuation Exercise

An evacuation exercise was held by the Flisvos Marina Administration on February 18th, 2015. The scenario involved finding a suspicious object in one of the shops. The aim of the exercise was to inform the employees about the method for evacuating the shops and what procedures to follow in an emergency. This exercise had the twofold purpose of protecting human lives and safeguarding the property.



Pollution Emergency Exercise

A Pollution Emergency Exercise was successfully held at Flisvos Marina on June 10th, 2015. The exercise was organised by the marina's Administration in partnership with Environmental Protection Engineering S.A.. The exercise was deemed to be highly satisfactory, as the existing action plan for dealing with sea pollution emergencies at Flisvos Marina worked perfectly. The Marina personnel who, according to the exercise scenario, will have to deal with such a potential pollution incident showed the necessary professionalism and discipline and was consistent throughout the exercise, successfully taking all the necessary actions.



Man at Sea - CPR

The training was provided by the Flisvos Marina Administration Body in partnership with the Hellenic Lifeguard Academy (ENAK) on May 14th, 2015. The training focused on basic life support techniques, such as the Primary Assessment, CPR and rescue breaths. The training included a lesson in rescuing theory and hands-on practice using a CPR mannequin, so that the participants would acquire some basic knowledge and be able to take action in an emergency. The training was attended by the marina's personnel, yacht crews, shop employees and even visitors.



Firefighting exercise

The annual firefighting exercise was held on October 26th, 2015 with great success. Its aim was to inform the employees about the firefighting equipment available at the marina and inside the shops, how to use it and what procedures to follow in an emergency. This exercise had the twofold purpose of protecting human lives and safeguarding the property.



Defibrillator Tutoring

On November 11th, 2015 the defibrillator training took place. The training consisted of basic knowledge, so that participants (marina's staff) can and be able to react in the case of an emergency.

Pollution Emergency Exercise

On November 19th, 2015 a Pollution Emergency Exercise was successfully held at Flisvos Marina. The exercise was organized by the marina's management, Lamda Flisvos Marina S.A., in partnership with Environmental Protection Engineering S.A. The aim of the exercise was to practice the pollution emergency methods and provide any relevant information on new methods.
